Certified Crop Adviser Exams

The first CCA exam in 1996 is being held at the Adams County Fairgrounds near Brighton. Ninety applicants have registered for the National exam and 76 applicants will take the Colorado exam. This year the Colorado exam will be "equated" with the 1995 exam. This is a process whereby the results of the two exams will be compared and the passing score of the 1996 exam will be adjusted upwards or downwards from the 1995 passing score of 70. This is being done to ensure that the degree of difficulty of the Colorado exam will be comparable from year to year. The National CCA has used this process in the National exams since its inception in 1992.

The second CCA exam in 1996 will be held Friday, August 2 at Adams State College in Alamosa. Both National and State exams will be given. This location was chosen to give better access to those in the San Luis Valley and the West Slope; however, anyone in the state may attend. The deadline for registration has not been announced, but probably will be about June 15.
